KNICKS CHRIS DUHON MAKES AN ASSIST WITH CHILDREN'S HEALTH FUND

NEW YORK, NY (February 17, 2010)—New York Knicks point guard Chris Duhon is partnering up with the Children's Health Fund (CHF) to use his assists to support their work. Duhon will donate \$100 for every assist he has in the regular season to the Children's Health Fund upon its conclusion.

Currently, Duhon has contributed 320 assists. In the 2008-09 season, he tallied a total of 566.

"I'm excited about this challenge," said Duhon. "Being the point guard of the team, my job is to find the man with the open shot. When I do, I'm rewarded with an assist and in turn, that will help the Children's Health Fund."
