Children's Health Project of Detroit at Event Featuring
U.S. Sen. Debbie Stabenow, Singer Paul Simon,

WHO: Children's Health Fund President and Co-founder **Irwin Redlener, M.D.**, will be joined by Henry Ford Health System President and CEO **Nancy Schlichting, U.S. Sen. Debbie Stabenow** (D-MI) and singer/songwriter **Paul Simon**, along with other local dignitaries.

WHAT: The Children's Health Project of Detroit will be launched to address the city's health crisis. The new program features a mobile medical clinic that will provide comprehensive health services to medically underserved children at schools and in community locations. Among the services to be provided are primary care, physical and sports examinations, immunizations, and vision and dental services.
