The Nevada Children's Health Project (NVCHP), in partnership with Nevada Health Centers, Inc. (NVHC), provides comprehensive health care services to children and families in the Las Vegas area and in isolated communities throughout the state. NVCHP aims to provide comprehensive healthcare services to Nevada's most under-resourced children through the use of mobile medical and fixed-site clinics. The mobile medical unit primarily serves children and adolescents ages 0-21 in the greater Las Vegas area, many of whom are unstably housed, have run away from home, or have been victims of human trafficking.
